The INFUUSIONS Mission Statement

To maintain a system of group giving that provides opportunities for enriching daily lives or enhancing life skills in the local community

Why join a giving circle?

Membership in a giving circle enables each individual to hear and learn from others. Each member brings unique community connections and involvement via research of prospective recipients. Bundling of individual donations multiplies the impact.

INFUUSIONS Giving Summary

Since 2002, INFUUSIONS has given over \$194000 to 33 local agencies. Examples include Durham Community Land Trustee, Threshold Clubhouse, StepUp, Church World Service, Musical Empowerment, and Durham Literacy/Achievement Academy.

INFUUSIONS Funding Process

Each organization is carefully researched by an INFUUSIONS member. Recipient charities are nominated and funding decisions are by consensus. We discuss how the goals and programs of the organizations mesh with our mission statement.

Tax Deductions

All organizations that are funded have 501 3C status. This has made it possible for Eno River Unitarian Universalist Fellowship (ERUUF), as part of their social justice program, to serve as the conduit for collecting donations, keeping records and distributing funds to the recipient organizations. Donations are recorded as a gift to ERUUF for tax purposes.

Meeting Times

The INFUUSIONS giving circle meets quarterly. It is permissible for members to pledge without attending meetings.

Membership

Membership is open to anyone who makes at least the minimum annual contribution. The minimum contribution to join is \$100/year and the recommended contribution is \$300 per person per year. Members are encouraged to develop a personal connection with at least one of the organizations that receive InfUusions funds.
